Highlights of April 6th Chapter Meeting

President George Dennis called the meeting to order at noon. Attendance was very low but the quality of those present proved once again an old adage that "size doesn't matter". Never-the-less this situation plus the fact that the President, Secretary, Treasurer and at least one other regular attendee will not be in town for the May meeting, warranted a discussion about continuing meetings during the summer. Since the Tower Club charges for a minimum of ten luncheons, it was unanimously agreed that chapter meetings will be cancelled until September. All members will be so notified by this newsletter in the immediate future but no further newsletters will be issued until the September 9th meeting is announced.

President Dennis was the speaker today. He was in the Navy in WWII and served in the Pacific Theater. He was strongly moved and associated with the time in history related in a recent book by James Bradley entitled "Flyboys: A True Story of Courage". He highlighted the book for us. It is a recounting of happenings and atrocities that occurred for some who flew in the Pacific air campaign. It also related explicitly to events on the island of Chichi Jima, near the infamous Iwo Jima. George accompanied his talk with numerous personal pictures and souvenirs obtained at that time. The subject was of obvious interest and resulted in others recounting war experiences of their own. This book was recommended to anyone who wants a thought provoking look at the Pacific conflict, as viewed by both sides. James Bradley's first book, "Flag of Our Fathers" was a chronicle of the lives of the six men who raised the flag on Iwo Jima. The author's father was one of those men. It too received rave reviews.
